

NATSAL-4 PROBABILITY PANEL WEB FOLLOW-UP QUESTIONNAIRE

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General user notes

1. This questionnaire was administered online to web-follow up (WFU) respondents in the probability panel arm of Natsal-4.
2. Throughout the questionnaire, **variable names** are shown in dark blue font.
3. **Question routing** is shown in black bold font underneath variable names and was used to ensure that respondents were only asked questions relevant to them. For example: IF (AskCasiN4=1 'Has had sex since turning 13') THEN
4. Text in red above the variable names gives the **routing instructions** in plain English.
5. Text fills are presented in '<> or ()', with routing instructions for text fills given in plain English (e.g., <text fill for transgender or non-binary respondents: 'This does not apply'>.
6. Respondents who told us that they had not had sex since turning 13 at the First Sexual Experiences section skipped most of the self-completion questions relating to sexual behaviour as the questions. The background variable AskCasiN4 was used to route respondents through the questionnaire according to whether they have had sex or not.
7. We recommend users read notes corresponding to particular modules before proceeding to these sections of the questionnaire.

Notes on specific questionnaire modules

Natsal-4 definitions of sexual experience and sex

Natsal-4 distinguishes between **sexual experience** (touching, kissing, anything else that might have felt sexual) and **sex**. Sex is defined differently for opposite sex pairings vs the other five respondent-partner pairings.

Definition of opposite sex sex

Opposite sex is defined as between **a cisgender man and a cisgender woman**. Opposite sex sex is defined as oral, vaginal, or anal sex. Help screens shown to respondents in these modules were:

ORAL SEX: A person's mouth on a partner's genital area.

VAGINAL SEX (vaginal sexual intercourse): A person's penis in a partner's vagina.

ANAL SEX (anal sexual intercourse): A person's penis in a partner's anus (rectum or back passage).

Definition of same sex sex

Same sex sex is defined as between either **two cisgender men or two cisgender women**.

Same sex sex is defined as oral, vaginal, or anal sex or any other genital contact. Help screens shown to respondents in these modules were:

ORAL SEX: A person's mouth on a partner's genital area.

(If respondent is a cisgender woman): **VAGINAL SEX:** Inserting something, e.g. a finger, hand, sex toy, or something else into a partner's vagina.

(If respondent is a cisgender man): **ANAL SEX** (anal sexual intercourse): A person's penis in a partner's anus (rectum or back passage).

(If respondent is a cisgender woman): **ANAL SEX:** Inserting something, e.g. a finger, hand, sex toy, or something else into a partner's anus (rectum or back passage).

OTHER GENITAL CONTACT: For example, stimulating by the genital area finger or hand.

Definition of sex for all other respondent-partner gender pairings

There are four other respondent-partner pairings besides opposite sex and same sex. For these four others, sex is defined as oral, vaginal, or anal sex or any other genital contact. Help screens shown to respondents in these modules were:

ORAL SEX: A person's mouth on a partner's genital area.

(If there **was** a penis involved: **VAGINAL SEX** (vaginal sexual intercourse): A person's penis in a partner's vagina.

(If there **was not** a penis involved: **VAGINAL SEX:** Inserting something, e.g. a finger, hand, sex toy, or something else into a partner's vagina.

(If there **was** a penis involved: **ANAL SEX** (anal sexual intercourse): A person's penis in a partner's anus (rectum or back passage).

(If there **was not** a penis involved: **ANAL SEX:** Inserting something, e.g. a finger, hand, sex toy, or something else into a partner's anus (rectum or back passage).

OTHER GENITAL CONTACT: For example, stimulating by the genital area finger or hand.

Textfills

The computer program showed '(man/men/he/him/his)' or '(woman/women/she/her)' in questions, depending on the gender of the partner being asked about.

First sexual experiences module

There are a total of **six loops** in the first sexual experiences module: one for each of respondent's first sexual experiences with three different genders (men, women, and trans/non-binary partners), with separate loops for cisgender respondents and trans/gender diverse respondents.

The order in which respondents were asked about first sexual experience with each of the three genders was based on the gender they reported as their first sexual experience (variable Part1Sex). For cisgender respondents, the combinations are opposite sex, same sex, and sex with a trans/non-binary partner. Trans/gender diverse respondents were asked similar questions about male, female, or transgender or non-binary partners (according to which genders they had had sexual experience with).

Sexual practices and numbers of partners modules

There are a total of **six loops** in the sexual practices and numbers of partners modules, respectively: one for each gender with whom the respondent reporting having sex with since turning 13 (men, women, and trans/non-binary partners), with separate loops for cisgender respondents and trans/gender diverse respondents.

Cisgender respondents were asked about opposite sex partners first, then same sex partners, and then transgender and non-binary partners. Transgender and non-binary respondents were asked about sex with women first, then men, and then transgender and non-binary partners.

Reproductive health module

This section was asked of respondents whose sex described at birth was female (question: SexBirth_Final), regardless of the respondent's current gender identity, and who have had sex with a partner of any gender since turning 13. This included respondents who have only had sex with women, as they may have conceived through in vitro fertilisation (IVF). An additional answer option of 'this does not apply' appeared at the question CurrPreg for transgender and non-binary respondents whose sex at birth was female.

Sexual transmitted infections module

Most questions in this section (e.g. questions on use of sexual health services and diagnosis of sexually transmitted infections) were only asked of respondents who said they had had sex since turning 13.
